# Content Asset Playbook

## brownsvilledeckbuilding.com

112 asset ideas across infographics, checklists, quizzes, reports, questionnaires, slide decks, videos and how-tos — each mapped to a keyword target and a job: *rank, earn links, or convert a lead you can sell.*

**The rank-and-rent filter.** This site isn't a brand — it's a lead machine. Every asset below must do at least one of three jobs, and the best ones do two. If an idea doesn't map to a job, it doesn't get built. That's the whole discipline.

**Job codes:** **RANK** pulls organic traffic for a target query **LINKS** earns citations that lift the whole domain  
**CONVERT** turns a visitor into a callable lead **ENGAGE** boosts dwell time & return visits

### Your current gap

The site already runs 7 blog posts, a planning checklist, a knowledge quiz and flashcards. That's a good skeleton, but it's all **bottom-of-page filler** — nothing on the site is currently link-worthy. For rank-and-rent, domain authority is the constraint, not content volume. The single highest-leverage move on this list is **the annual cost report (\$4)**, because original pricing data is the one thing other sites cite without being asked.

**Your unfair local angle.** Brownsville isn't just "hot and humid" — it's one of the most humid cities in America, it sits in the Texas coastal windstorm zone (Cameron County requires **WPI-8 windstorm certification** for TWIA-insurable structures), it gets salt-laden air off the Gulf, and it has a June–November hurricane season plus year-round termite pressure. No national deck site covers this. Every asset below should be built on that angle — it's what makes thin local content rankable.

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## 01 Infographics

Purpose: link bait and image-search traffic. Publish each on its own indexable page with real body copy around it (Google can't read a PNG), plus an embed-code box so anyone who steals it links back.

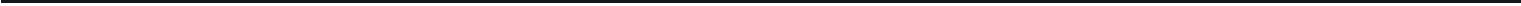
**Distribution that actually works:** Pinterest (home-improvement queries are massive there), Reddit r/HomImprovement and r/Decks when genuinely useful, local RGV Facebook groups, and cold outreach to Texas home-service blogs offering the graphic free with attribution. One accepted embed from a .edu extension service or a county page is worth fifty directory citations.

## 02 Checklists

Purpose: the workhorse. Checklists rank for cheap long-tail queries, gate well as PDFs, and put the visitor in a decision-making frame — which is exactly when they call. Publish the full checklist on-page (so it ranks) and offer the printable PDF for a phone number (so it converts).

### 03 Quizzes & Interactive Tools

Purpose: dwell time and lead capture. A quiz that ends in a personalized result is the most natural place on the whole site to ask for a phone number — the visitor has already invested eight clicks. Gate the *detailed* result, not the headline result.

## 04 Reports & Original Data Studies ← highest priority

Purpose: backlinks, and nothing else. This is the only category on the list that reliably earns editorial links, which is the actual bottleneck for a rank-and-rent domain. Original data doesn't need to be expensive — a thermometer, a spreadsheet, and a public-records request cover most of it.

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## 05 The 50-Question Homeowner Questionnaire

Delivered as a separate finished asset (PDF + HTML). Here's how to deploy it so it earns its keep.

### **Publish the full 50 on-page**

Every question as an <h3> with a short answer-guidance paragraph beneath. This is a long-tail keyword farm — dozens of "should I ask my contractor about \_\_\_\_" queries land on one page.

### **Gate the printable PDF**

Name + phone for the fillable checklist version. That phone number is the product you're renting out.

### **Add FAQPage schema**

Mark up 8–10 of the questions. Rich results expand your SERP footprint dramatically for a page that's already ranking.

### **Slice it into micro-content**

50 questions = 50 social posts, 50 short-form video scripts, 10 blog posts of 5 questions each, and one slide deck. Write once, publish forty times.

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## 06 Slide Decks

Purpose: parasite properties and embeds. A deck uploaded to SlideShare / Scribd / Google Slides creates an indexed asset on a high-authority domain that links back to you, and embedding it on the matching page raises time-on-page.

## 07 Videos

Purpose: YouTube is the second-largest search engine and its results appear inside Google's. Embedding your own YouTube videos on service pages also measurably increases dwell time — a signal that matters when you're competing against thin competitor pages.

## Short-form (Shorts / Reels / TikTok, 20–45 sec)

- **Red flag series** — one contractor red flag per clip, 50 clips straight out of the questionnaire.
- **Before / after reveals** — highest engagement rate in home services, near-zero production cost.
- **"Would you sign this?"** — hold up a real estimate, point at the vague line item.
- **Material myth-busting** — "composite doesn't fade" and other lies, 30 seconds each.
- **Geo-targeted clips** — one per service area (Harlingen, McAllen, South Padre, Los Fresnos, Rancho Viejo, Port Isabel). Cheap geographic relevance signals for pages that would otherwise be thin doorway pages.

**On geo pages:** your secondary-city pages are the biggest algorithmic risk in a rank-and-rent build. A page that's the Brownsville page with the city name swapped is a doorway page. Give each one something real

— local permit office details, a neighborhood the page actually names, a photo, a 30-second video — or don't publish it.

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## 08 How-To Guides

Purpose: informational traffic that you funnel internally to the money pages. Every how-to should end with the honest "here's when to stop DIYing and call someone" section — that's the handoff into a lead. Add HowTo schema where the steps are genuinely sequential.

## 09 Build Order

If you build in this order, each phase makes the next one easier to rank.

### Conversion mechanics worth fixing first

1. **Call tracking on every asset.** Use a distinct tracked number per asset type so you can prove to the renting contractor which content produced which lead — that's your pricing leverage at renewal.
2. **Sticky mobile call bar.** Most home-service traffic is mobile and most leads are calls, not forms.
3. **Two-step forms.** Ask the easy question first (ZIP or project type), then contact details. Meaningfully higher completion than a single form.
4. **Lead-quality filter.** Add a budget-range question. A contractor pays more per lead when the junk is already screened out.
5. **Speed-to-lead.** Route form fills to SMS instantly. Lead value decays by the minute, and this is the easiest thing to sell a renter on.

### Two risks specific to this model

**Trust signals.** The site presents as a matching service for vetted pros — keep that framing honest and explicit. Content that implies a crew you don't have is both a liability and, if Google reads the site as a fake

local business, a ranking risk. "We connect you with vetted Brownsville deck builders" is a fine, rankable, defensible position.

**Reusability.** Build every asset with the city name in a variable, not hard-coded into the design file. When this site works, you'll want to clone the whole library into McAllen, Harlingen and Corpus Christi in an afternoon rather than a month.

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**Sources for the underlying data:** Decks.com cost calculator and contractor-question guidance; Trex Protect 2026 installation cost data; City of Brownsville permitting; TWIA windstorm certification / WPI-8 requirements; WorldAtlas humidity rankings.

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
